Arriving in Germany

The Integration Information and Consultation service offers advice and support on an individual basis. Together, a process for successful integration is developed. This case-management method focuses on the personal situation of the migrant, with the aim of offering help to self-help.

In addition, integration advisors participate in local networks, contribute to the intercultural expansion of services and promote public awareness thereof.

The following topics can be addressed by new immigrants during a consultation:

- Legal questions regarding stay.
- The acquisition of German language skills and opportunities for improvement.
- School programs, vocational training, certification of professional qualifications.
- Job search.
- Financial questions, e.g., income.
- Living conditions, e.g. housing search, financing an apartment.
- Health, e.g., health insurance, medical care, health problems.
- Marriage, family, pregnancy and child-raising.
- Mobility and transportation.
- Recreation and leisure, e.g., club membership.
- Everyday activities, e.g., contact with authorities, grocery and other forms of shopping.
